




# IMPACT OF THE ECONOMY ON EMPLOYMENT CLAIMS!






#### **MASS LAYOFFS: THIRD QUARTER 2012**

**27 or More Weeks: 39.1%** 







#### **RETALIATION CHARGES (2006 - 2012)**



#### **AGE DISCRIMINATION CHARGES (2006-2012)**



#### FAIR CREDIT REPORTING ACT


- \* Strict Requirements
- \* State Law May be More Restrictive (e.g. Arizona, California, Hawaii, Massachusetts)
- \* Significant Exposure
- \* Class Action




- \* EEOC LITIGATION
- \* Jan. 11, 2012: Pepsi and EEOC Reach \$3.1 Million settlement on claim that Pepsi's criminal background check policy had a disparate impact on African American applicants.
- \* Dec. 21, 2010: EEOC Sues Kaplan Higher Education in an Ohio federal court alleging the company's use of job applicants' credit history discriminated against job candidates on the basis of race.
