Frequently Used Codes for Nutrition Services

The medical nutrition therapy (MNT) CPT codes are used by many third party payers, including Medicare. These codes best describe the MNT services that registered dietitians provide to patients.

97802 Medical nutrition therapy; initial assessment and intervention, individual, face-to-face with

the patient, each 15 minutes.

97803 reassessment and intervention, individual, face-to-face with the patient, each 15 minutes.

97804 group (2 or more individual(s)), each 30 minutes.

Additional Codes Used by RDs (refer to CPT book for full code description):

G0270 Medical nutrition therapy; reassessment and subsequent intervention(s) following second

referral in same year for change in diagnosis, medical condition, or treatment regimen,

individual, face-to-face with the patient, each 15 minutes.

G0271 group (2 or more individual(s)), each 30 minutes.

G0108 Diabetes outpatient self-management training services, individual, per 30 minutes.

G0109 Diabetes outpatient self-management training services, group session (2 or more), per 30

minutes.

98960–98962 Education and training for patient self-management by a qualified, nonphysician health

care professional using a standardized curriculum, face-to-face with the patient (could

include caregiver/family).

98966–98968 Telephone assessment and management service provided by a qualified nonphysician

health care professional.

98969 Online assessment and management service provided by a qualified nonphysician health

care professional, internet or electronic communications.

99071 Educational supplies, such as books, tapes, and pamphlets, provided by the physician (or

other qualified health care professional) for the patient's education at cost to physician.

99366 and 99368 Medical team conference, with and without the patient and/or family.
